YOUR STICKERS

Your stickers are on US Letter size pages (8.5 x 11 inches) but can be printed on A4 size paper without issue. Follow the directions below.

These stickers can be used with most common planners and bullet journals (depending on the size of the stickers and your planner) and also many craft projects or scrapbooking.

TIPS FOR PRINTING

If printing at home you will need:

- + White full sheet sticker paper (for more details see below)
- + A printer. The quality of the print will depend on the quality of your printer but many lower priced printers will give you a great result providing you use the suggestions below. I print all my pages on an Epson XP-200 (which retailed for around \$50) and I love the prints.
- + Printer ink. Ensure your printer has sufficient ink because low levels can affect print quality and colours.

When printing color stickers, best results are achieved by using a Photo quality print setting however there are exceptions. Sometimes, printing with the Text/Image setting will yield results that are not too different to the higher quality setting. Try doing a test print with the two settings and see what you think. Using the Text/Image setting will also use less ink which is a bonus.

Print with the following settings:

- + Print Actual size.
- + In the Orientation setting check Auto Portrait/Landscape. This will ensure your print is centred on the page.
- + Choose your colour mode.
- + Select appropriate paper size – US Letter or A4.
- + Select appropriate paper type or a setting that is the closest match to your chosen paper i.e. Matte, Glossy etc.
- + Choose your desired image quality setting.

Please be aware that the final print colours may vary slightly from what you see on your computer screen. Unfortunately, this is unavoidable due to variations with monitors, printers and the settings you use when printing.

If you are outside the US and use A4 paper (like me), the above print settings will work. You do not need to adjust sizing or any other settings. The only difference is that you may have slightly more space at the top and bottom of your print.

PAPER CHOICE

- + You can find sticker paper in most office supply stores and it is available in matte and glossy finishes. While glossy stickers will give you lovely vibrant colours, the surface can be difficult to write on so keep that in mind when choosing a sticker paper. Matte paper is great to write on, but the colors will be less vibrant than glossy paper.
- + When printing stickers I use a 130gsm sticker paper (matte and glossy) and find the thickness perfect for my planner. 130gsm paper also works well with most printers and cutting machines. If you use a thicker paper you may find your printer jams and the stickers are too thick for your planner.
- + Not all sticker papers are created equal. I have tested several sticker papers (branded and generic) and have been both frustrated and excited with the results. Unfortunately it is often a case of trial and error before you find the perfect paper. More than likely you will have to do test prints and tinker with the print settings to get a great print. And don't be afraid to try something different if the colors look off or you aren't happy. I get the best results on my glossy sticker paper using the Plain Paper setting rather than the Glossy Photo Paper setting.

CUTTING YOUR STICKERS

- + By hand – use scissors or a craft knife/scalpel to cut out your stickers. This can be a little tedious but if you make a night of it while watching your favourite television show time can go pretty quickly. If using a scalpel make sure you have a cutting mat to protect surfaces and a ruler for cutting straight edges.
- + By Cutting Machine – Use your Silhouette or Cricut cutting machine to cut out your files. Your purchase includes two files that can be used with a cutting machine. I own a Silhouette machine so I'm not sure how the Cricut Cutter works and what file types are needed. Hopefully the following files will be of use. The first file is a black PNG Cutting Template which can be used to trace outlines within your cutting machine software. The other file is a DXF file which includes premade cutting outlines so you do not need to trace your stickers.
- + If you plan on cutting a lot of stickers and see your sticker obsession continuing, a cutting machine is a life saver and well worth the investment. And it's not limited to just stickers...you can cut almost anything and most certainly any paper or light card that you need in craft, scrapbooking and school projects.
